

Approved Meeting Minutes
O'HARE NOISE COMPATIBILITY COMMISSION

Approval of the March 7, 2017 ONCC Executive Committee Meeting Minutes.

Mr. Ryan moved to approve the March 7, 2017 meeting minutes. Dr. Kuper seconded the motion.

a. ONCC Ad Hoc Fly Quiet Committee

Mr. Annunzio reported the Fly Quiet Committee met and discussed the survey questions for the Fly Quiet Test 2. CDA also presented a draft Fly Quiet Test 3 for member consideration.

Mayor Juracek said there was good discussion and suggested each community doing their own survey. She noted a survey would be good to have in general and said there was also good discussion about a potential Fly Quiet Test 3.

b. ONCC Ad Hoc Nominating Committee Report

Ms. Camacho reported the Nominating Committee met in April. Mayor Sherwin said no nominations were received.

Ms. Camacho said Mr. Annunzio, Mayor Juracek and Dr. Kuper expressed interest in continuing their roles on ONCC.

c. ONCC Guest Speaker at May 5, 2017 ONCC Meeting – Carl Burleson, FAA

Mayor Juracek said the FAA asked for topics of interest that Mr. Burleson can discuss at the meeting. She suggested having him talk about the 20 Airport Study and finding out the status.

Mr. Annunzio suggested asking what ONCC can do to help.

Dr. Kuper asked if Stage 4, 5 and 6 had been defined.

Mr. Frame replied he did not know about the status of Stage 5 and 6 but noted Stage 4 had federal standards.

Ms. Dunlap said NextGen would not be something Mr. Burleson may talk about but perhaps he could reference it.

Mayor Juracek suggested a discussion on Metroplex and how it would factor into O'Hare. She also asked if he would be able to speak about privatizing controllers.

Mr. Frame replied he wasn't sure if the FAA would talk about pending legislation.

Ms. Guziel suggested one of the topics could be about the CLEEN initiative.

Dr. Kuper suggested giving Mr. Burleson a list of questions and let him choose the ones he would like to go over.

Mayor Juracek noted the main topics for discussion would be the 20 Airport Study and CLEEN.

d. Review/Edit Draft ONCC May 5, 2017 Agenda

Mayor Juracek reviewed the draft May 5 ONCC meeting agenda.

Comments from the Public:

Mr. Dwyer, a resident of Medinah, said he was concerned with the test because some questions were not being asked. He said he would hope to see some initiative established for the 6 month period after Test 3.

Mayor Juracek said a rotation test could not exceed 6 months.

Mr. Dwyer said the FFA had not followed Fly Quiet procedures since 2013 and noted they continued with daytime operations at night.

Mr. Frank Icuss, a resident of Chicago, asked if someone from ONCC could ask FAA representatives to explain why planes do a sharp bank after takeoffs and deviate from runway direction. He also noted aircraft go south and north over Harlem Avenue.

Mayor Juracek suggested a Flight Track 101 meeting.

Ms. Dunlap said noise contour and flight track were not the same. She noted night flights weigh more heavily and said it may not be planes banking but rather they were vectoring.

Mr. Icuss said he understood safety but asked if planes bank because they were benefitting the airlines or the residents on the ground.

Adjournment

Mr. Ryan moved to adjourn the meeting. Dr. Kuper seconded the motion. The meeting ended at 11:08 a.m.
