The O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission provides a public forum to address community noise issues related to aircraft operations at O'Hare International Airport. The Commission recognizes that public input is important and appreciates your cooperation by following these guidelines:

All meetings of the O'Hare Commission and any O'Hare Commission committee shall be public meetings except as provided in the Open Meetings Act. Public comments will be limited to **3 minutes**.

The following Rules of Decorum will apply to all meetings:

- Any person making offensive, insulting, threatening, slanderous or obscene remarks or makes threats against any person or against public order or security while in the meeting shall be removed at the direction of the presiding officer from further audience unless permission to continue is granted by the majority vote of the committee/commission.
- Comments are limited to those which address meeting agenda items, or those that are included as part of the Commission's Work Plan, which focuses on aircraft noise mitigation and abatement at O'Hare International Airport.
- Persons wishing to address the ONCC must be present and complete the comment card outlining the question or area to be addressed. Before making comments, they shall identify

themselves to the Chair and Commission members by stating either their name, address, community or ward.

- Comments beyond ONCC's purview will not be allowed to be verbally given, but a written set of comments may be submitted for consideration to be added to the meeting minutes.

Meeting attendees are reminded that ONCC has taken a neutral position on the O'Hare Modernization Program as reflected in the FAA's Record of Decision.
