Hosts Aviation Experts at National Night Out*

Des Plaines, Ill., Aug. X, 2012—Watch simulated O'Hare International Airport flight patterns displayed in the Chicago Department of Aviation's Community Outreach Vehicle Tuesday, Aug. 7, from 6 to 8 p.m. during Chicago's National Night Out observance at the Chicago Police 25th District headquarters, 5555 W. Grand Ave.

CDA and O'Hare Noise Compatibility Commission representatives will answer questions from residents about the O'Hare Modernization Program timetable of runway construction and aircraft noise abatement.

The family-friendly CDA hybrid bus features video presentations, demonstration of the Airport Noise Monitoring System, and computer-generated flight paths over specific neighborhoods.

The National Night Out program involves citizens, law enforcement agencies, civic groups and local organizations in more than 15,000 communities to strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships.

ONCC, composed of representatives from 28 Cook and DuPage communities, Cook County, and 16 school districts, strives to reduce the impact of aircraft noise on surrounding neighborhoods of O'Hare International Airport through home and school insulation, and to reduce, wherever possible, aircraft noise at its source.
